### Benefits to the individual:


- It's the journey not the destination

- Provides credentials that are valued in the industry



# Scoring

- Passing score established via a systematic procedure (Cutscore study)
- Minimum competency level
- Scaled score of at least 550 required to obtain certification (range 200-750)
- Email & written notification of exam results

- Practice taking CSQE exam questions use the results to focus your study
- Don't memorize things you don't need to know look them up
- Take a preparation course like this one

# Tip When Taking the CSQE Exam


- Read each question carefully
- Read all 4 answers carefully
- SKIP & come back to any questions that:
  - You need to look up
  - Require anything more than simple math
- Guess
- Don't change your answers
- Use a calculator
- Keep track of your time
